	OTTOMAN EMPIRE	CHINA	JAPAN	RUSSIAN EMPIRE: EXAMPLE
SOCIAL INTERACTIONS AND ORGANIZATION				CAUSATION: Tsar Alexander the II freed the Russian serfs. This was caused by his fear that if they weren't freed from the top, they would be freed from the bottom, meaning by revolution or revolt.
HUMANS AND THE ENVIRONMENT				COMPARISON: Russia had a vast area to expand nearly without opposition. They were able to gain land from the Ottoman Empire, in Central Asia and in the Far East. This gave them access to vast natural resource potential. By comparison Japan was an island nation with very limited natural resources.
GOVERNANCE/ POLITICAL				CCOT: After the 1905 Revolution Tsar Nicholas II created the first Russian legislature the Duma. Although this granted Russians a greater voice in governance, it was ineffective and didn't lead to reform with the Tsar maintaining ultimate authority.
